



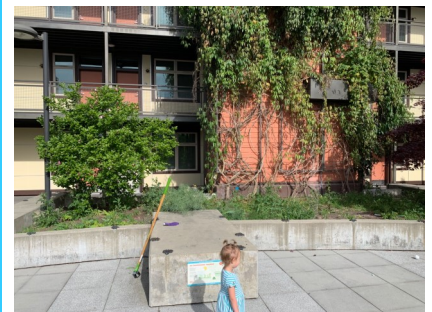
TO ALL THE DADS AT FVI: HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!!

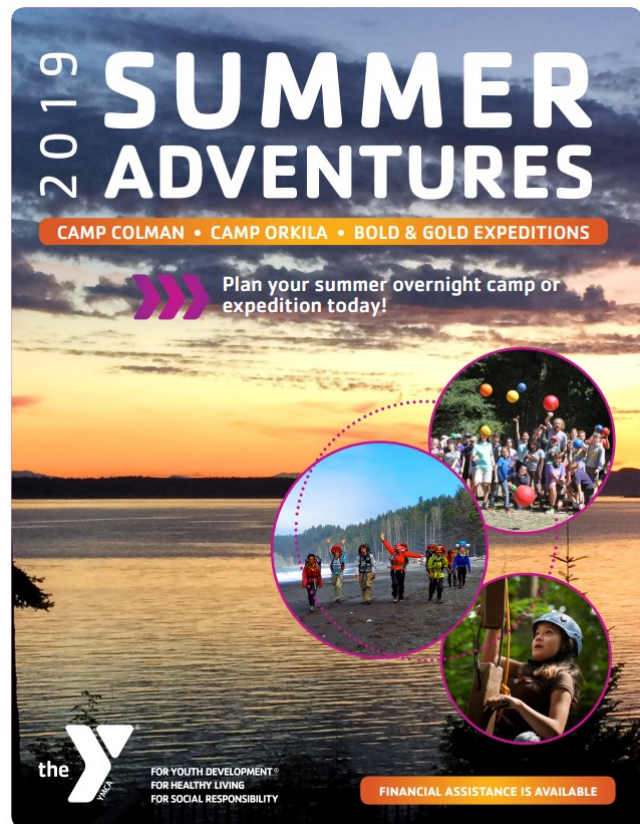
