Property Happenings

Safety Tips

You can take the following steps to protect yourself from package theft during the holiday season and all year:

Track your package, and request email or text alerts about its delivery status.

Some shipping companies will allow you to choose a preferred time and date, or to change a delivery location when the package is in route.

Require a signature for your deliveries.

If you frequently receive deliveries to your residence, consider purchasing a locking parcel delivery box that can be secured.

Ship your package to a location where someone you know will be available to receive it, such as your workplace or the home of a relative, neighbor or friend.

Consider using other delivery options that are available. Many retailers and shipping companies may deliver to other secured locations, including lockers, or allow you to pick up your package at a retail store or package center.

If no other option is available, provide specific instructions about where the package should be left on your property. Choose a location that conceals the item, so people walking or driving in your neighborhood cannot see it. If you are going on vacation, place deliveries on hold until you return home.

Be a good neighbor — be alert:

If you see a package being stolen from your neighbor's home, call 911.

To report suspicious activity, call the Issaquah Police Department's non-emergency line at 425-837-3200.
