In addition to housing, YWCA offers participants and community members access to onsite supportive services. These supportive services are designed to teach skills that empowers and allows community bonding.

By offering affordable housing and integrated supportive services to participants and the community, YWCA helps to combat economic disparities that can block a community from thriving.

YWCA Family Village Issaquah recognizes a thriving community empowers its' members in turn leading to kinship and pride.

Challenges in our Community

- In East King County the number one cause of homelessness is a lack of affordable housing.
- Women in King county are 41% of individuals experiencing homelessness of which 10% were fleeing domestic violence.
- In 2020, 29% of families with children were unsheltered in King County


Community-Centered Thriving Community
