Emergency Housing "Welcome Home" Program

Our "Welcome Home" program furnishes YWCA shelter units for families before they arrive with items to make their new housing into a home.

What do our emergency shelter families need?

New and gently used items to make a home comfortable and to keep households clean. We use donations to create "Welcome Home" kits by room to help fully furnish an apartment.
